ENTRIES: Mail complete entry to: Mike Taylor, Show Secretary, 1352 W Syphon Road, Pocatello, ID 83204. Make checks payable to: **MV IDEA**. Classes filled on a first-come first-served basis according to postmark. Entries not accepted without full payment, all signatures, and copies of membership cards or everification printout. Juniors must provide Medical Release Form. Adult Amateurs must show USEF Amateur card. Freestyle entries must include a copy of the qualifying test (60% score at highest test of level) with the exception of FEI YR and Junior Freestyles. Post entries will only be accepted if time slots are available with a late fee of \$15. Out of state competitors must provide a current negative Coggins and health certificate.

VACCINATION NOTICE: Exhibitors are reminded of USEF's new vaccination policy, effective 12/1/15; see GR845 for details. Download the form from: <https://www.usef.org/documents/membership/EquineVaccinationRecord.pdf> and bring the completed form, signed by your veterinarian, with you to the competition. If you select an alternative option under the rules, please bring required documentation. Competition Management reserves the right to review vaccination documentation. Non-compliant entries may be quarantined or denied permission to unload, and will not be allowed to compete nor to mingle with other horses. **No refunds will be given if right to compete is denied because the vaccination documentation is missing or incomplete.**

SPECIAL CLASSES: Second Level Test 3 (Class 217) offers a Dover Medal prize to the highest score of 60% or higher in the AA division. Opportunity Training Level Tests 1 & 2, and Opportunity First Level Tests 1 & 2 are classes made available for riders who are experimenting with dressage showing (USEF GR821). These entries must pay all other show related fees (office, grounds, and stabling, etc), but the Opportunity classes do not require the USEF/USDF drug fee or memberships or nonmember fees for either horse or rider/owner/trainer or coach. Riders entering Opportunity classes may not cross enter into the rated/recognized classes but they may enter into Intro A & B classes which are not rated/recognized. There will also be the following breed awards/points: High Score Arabian, TIP award (www.jockeyclub.com for more info), Friesian High Score (www.friesianheritage.com must be registered with the Heritage registry).

REFUNDS: Prior to closing date, all fees refunded except office fee. After the closing date, no refunds for any reason including Acts of God will be given. Drug, qualifying fees and facility fees will be refunded. No refunds on competition days. If wait listed entries cannot be accepted because of a full show, all fees will be refunded. Refunds will NOT be given for class cancellation due to severe weather, accident, or other emergency.

TIMES: The preferred method of notification for all entries is email, so please include a clearly readable email address with entry. It is the competitor's responsibility to confirm ride times on the day of the show.

AWARDS: Ribbons will be awarded first through third in each division. Awards to be given to first place and High Scores in each division. Ties will be broken in accordance with USEF DR123. In case of equality of points, the competitor with the highest marks received under General Impressions shall be declared the winner. When the scores for General Impressions are equal, the horses must remain tied. **Prize money will be offered for the highest 4 scores (over the two days) of the highest level test (Test 3) for Training through 2nd level with 3rd level and above being combined. Opportunity classes are not eligible. The prize money will be as follows: 1st = \$50 and 2nd = \$25.**

STABLING: \$75 for the weekend. Tack stalls available for \$25 for the weekend. Several stall sizes available: 11x13 cinderblock, 10x10 w/ open back, 10x10 complete enclosed. Please indicate desired size. Initial 1 bag of bedding provided. Please provide own hay. Additional bedding and hay will be available for purchase.

FOOTING: Warm up: Outdoor arena has well maintained and watered dirt footing. Outdoor Arena: 20 x 60 meters, well maintained and watered dirt footing. Lunging areas are available. Only horses with entries will be permitted in arenas. Numbers are required at all times when the horse is outside their stall.

CONCESSIONS: On grounds during show hours.

MEDICAL: Medical personnel on grounds during competition.

FARRIER AND VETERANARIAN: On call. Names and phone numbers will be posted in the stable area and show office. Sharps containers in the show office and in the barns.

SMOKING AND PETS: Will not be allowed on show grounds.

ACCOMMODATIONS: Camping on fairgrounds available at \$15 per night. Pay with entry. Alternatively, many available in Twin Falls.

DIRECTIONS: From the I-84, Exit 182, travel South towards Twin Falls, turn right on Pole Line Road and continue West approximately 5 miles. Turn left on More Road and continue South approx. 3.5 miles. Facility on your left. Watch for signs.
