If riding in Official 201 NAJYRC and USEF Qualifying classes and qualifying for Great American/USDF Championships pay the additional \$10 qualifying fee when appropriate. Measurement Card required & must be submitted with entry for FEI Pony Rider tests. Please specify Open (O), Adult Amateur (AA), Jr. Young Rider (Jr/YR) on entry form. If not specified, you will be placed in the Open division. FEI Pony for riders 12-16. Management reserves the right to cancel, combine, split classes, change arenas, or limit the number of rides per rider to facilitate the schedule. Management reserves the right to refuse any entry.

Freestyle music check will be conducted **each day** BEFORE the official show start time. Saturday Freestyles are performed in the evening as part of the Freestyle Challenge.

**If you would like your pony measured, please notify the Show Secretary by May 8, 2018. No exceptions.** Any person wanting pony measurements must contact the Show Secretary before the show to set a measurement time – we will tentatively measure ponies Friday evening, Saturday and Sunday during lunch times, but other times may be arranged. Owners will pay veterinarian directly for call charge.

Champion and Reserve Champion awarded in each division at each level. Combined score of two tests in that level to determine winner thru 2<sup>nd</sup> Level. 3<sup>rd</sup> Level and above, highest score. FEI Level will be combined. Also, the highest score achieved by one junior, one adult amateur, one open rider to be awarded each day.

**ENTRIES:** Make checks payable to **IDEA** and send to **SECRETARY** listed above. Use [Entry Form B](#) available at [idahodressageandeventing.org](http://idahodressageandeventing.org). Entries also available on [www.eqentries.com](http://www.eqentries.com). All entries must be **postmarked** by the closing date, any late entries will be accepted at the discretion of management and put on a waiting list. Classes filled on a first-come first-serve basis and the show fills fast. No assurances will be made until the schedule is printed. **\*All copies of membership cards must be included. Go to [eqverification.org](http://eqverification.org) to find and print them all in one place!** Except for USEF/USDF Championship classes and for FEI Pony Riders, FEI Junior, FEI Young Rider and FEI Para-Equestrian Freestyles, in order to enter a freestyle class at any level, **a horse/rider combination must have received a minimum score of 60% in the highest test of the declared freestyle level or any test of a higher level** at a Federation Licensed or FEI recognized Dressage Competition or “open” Dressage class (i.e. open to all breeds) at a Federation Licensed Competition held prior to the competition where the horse/rider combination is entered to ride a freestyle class. A photocopy of the test verifying eligibility or copy of the USDF score verification, must be submitted with the entry for a freestyle class.

**VACCINATIONS NOTICE:** Exhibitors are reminded of USEF's new vaccination policy, effective 12/1/15; see GR845 for details. Download the form from: <https://www.usef.org/documents/membership/EquineVaccinationRecord.pdf> and bring the completed form, signed by your veterinarian, with you to the competition. If you select an alternative option under the rules, please bring required documentation. Competition Management reserves the right to review vaccination documentation. Non-compliant entries may be quarantined or denied permission to unload, and will not be allowed to compete nor to mingle with other horses. **No refunds will be given if right to compete is denied because the vaccination documentation is missing or incomplete.**

**STABLING REQUIRED – PLEASE CONTACT IDAHO HORSE PARK AT [www.fordidahohorsepark.com](http://www.fordidahohorsepark.com) TO MAKE RESERVATION.** PACKAGE PRICE of \$125 for the show weekend (Friday thru Sunday, horse stall or tack stall), If arriving before 5/19 additional nights at \$17, initial bedding not provided. Feed and bedding available for purchase. Permanent covered stalls with full doors available. No Coggins required but see Vaccinations Notice above. **(DO NOT SEND YOUR STABLING INFO/PAYMENT WITH ENTRY...CONTACT HORSE PARK DIRECTLY ONLINE) PLEASE NOTE:** Competitors will be required to bring proof of stabling to office in order to receive show packet—no packet, no entry.

**AWARDS:** Prize to 1st place, ribbons to 6<sup>th</sup> place. Champion and Reserve for all levels and divisions. Combined score of two tests in that level to determine winner thru 2<sup>nd</sup> Level. 3<sup>rd</sup> Level and above, highest score. FEI Level will be combined. The highest score achieved by one junior, one adult amateur, one open rider to be awarded each day. TIP High Point will be awarded each day. Other Breed awards may be given. Please see website for updates.

**SCRATCHES/REFUNDS:** Please be aware of opening and closing dates. Refunds will be all fees minus \$50 cancellation fee prior to closing date. No refunds after closing date or at discretion of management.

**ARENAS:** All tests will be ridden in a 20x60 meter dressage arena (inside...all classes will be held inside) with sand/dirt footing. If Training Level is very full, we may change the arena to a 20x40 meter arena to accommodate more riders. Indoor holding/warmup area 95' x 175' (limited # of horses allowed, no lunging). Outdoor arena 150' x 300', lunging area 150' x 85', all sand.

**SPECIAL CLASSES:** Class 119/219 & 124/224 are offered as an additional opportunity to ride a qualifying ride. Please note you are allowed one Qualifying score per show. Opportunity Training Level Tests 1 & 2 (**Class 100/101, 200/201**) are classes made available for riders who are experimenting with dressage showing (USEF GR821). These entries must pay all other show related fees (office, grounds, stabling, etc.), but the Opportunity classes do not require the USEF/USDF drug fee or memberships or nonmember fees for horse/rider/ owner/trainer or coach. Riders entering Opportunity classes may not cross enter into the rated/recognized classes.

**SPECIAL EVENTS:** IDAHO FREESTYLE CHALLENGE / IDAHO DRESSAGE FESTIVAL SILENT AUCTION  
Saturday's freestyles will be automatically be part of the "Idaho Freestyle Challenge", with an opening purse of \$500! Purse will increase as the number of entries rise. The amount of the purse will be announced. The Challenge will all be ridden at the end of the day, where spectators can watch and take part in the concurrent wine and cheese reception and silent auction finale, ending the evening with the presentation of prizes. Scoring for placings are done across all levels of freestyles. See [www.idahodressageandeventing.org](http://www.idahodressageandeventing.org) for more details! Freestyle music check will be conducted **each day** BEFORE the official show start time.

**VENDORS:** There will be a collection of vendors present to support and shop with during the event!

**DOGS:** All dogs must be restrained on a leash at all times. No dogs are allowed in the Ford Idaho Center Arena or the Ford Sport Center Concession and Office area at any time. Pet owners will be responsible for clean-up of droppings.

**TIMES:** The preferred method of notification for all entries is email, so please include a clearly readable email address with entry. Ride times will also be posted at the show and available on Fox Village website. It is the competitor's responsibility to confirm ride times on the day of the show.

**FARRIER/VET:** Idaho Equine Hospital 208-466-4613 (next to Horse Park). Farrier on call is Myron Amsden 208-571-1878. Numbers will be posted on show grounds.

**NO SMOKING** in the Ford Idaho Center Arena or stable area.

**DIRECTIONS:** I-84 to exit 38, Garrity exit, in Nampa, Idaho. Approximately 40 minute drive from Oregon border. North on Garrity, thru a set of lights and turn right before the railroad tracks. Check in at office before you get to stabling.

Each competitor is responsible for supplying management with correct applicable numbers (USDF and USEF) for horse, owner, rider, and trainer, before the day(s) of the competition.

The scores of competitors who fail to supply correct numbers may not be counted toward national awards.
