



The USEA North Wind Winter Jumping Series 2017-18

Birt Arena, Hestehaven Lane (google map: 2520 E Lewis Lane), Nampa, ID

9a-10a Mid/High warm up, Mid/High show 10a- 12 noon (approx). *** Low Div Starts at 12 noon (or whenever High div ends, whichever is later), Low Div show (& 2'3" PM class) goes to approx. 5:30p. Indoor warm-ups between classes throughout the day. Outdoor warm-up all day.

Entries/Fees: \$15 Grounds fee per horse to off-set arena rental and insurance costs. \$10 per Class before closing date (must include payment with entry), postmarked after closing date \$13 per class. You may enter more than once in the same class for schooling, but only one may be judged- you must declare which will be judged with ring steward before starting the round. Classes may be split into Junior (under 18) and senior (18 and over) if 6 entries or more in a class. Please make Checks payable to the "Nancy Roché". Refunds in full (or applied to next show in current series) before closing date, after closing entries may be applied to another show in the series, minus \$15 grounds fee. Day of show scratches or no-shows, no refund or credit given. **Times:** Approximate ride times will be sent via email 3-4 days prior to the event. Post entries will be accepted if space allows, and put at the end of each class order. **Awards:** Award for 1st place if two or more in class. Ribbons thru 4th place. Year-end Winter Jumper Series Champion and Reserve Champion awarded to the same horse/rider combination for the series- Low jumper, Mid Jumper and High Jumper divisions. Points are as follows: 1st -50, 2nd - 25, 3rd -15, 4th -10. You do not need to enter every class of division! Must compete in 3 of the series shows in one division to be eligible for a year-end award in that division. **Ties:** In case of tie, pre-entered horse/rider will win over post-entered. If still tied, tie remains.

Warmups: There will be approximately one-hour open warm up time in the indoor arena prior to mid/high and low show. *****Note- 8 horses max in arena at any given time**, May limit time to 20-30 mins to allow for next group), plus you may warm up indoors while we set fences to a different height. You may lunge or ride outside as weather allows- no lunging in the indoor arena. Standing horses may be in the indoor holding area or held/tied outside per discretion of management. **Attire:** Clinic attire. Riding helmet and riding boots or paddock boots with half chaps preferred. **Other info:** Request a song and/or bring your own ipod or CD and we will play it for you! No dogs allowed on the grounds according with Birt Arena policies. Management reserves the right to excuse any competitor, trainer or spectator for unsportsmanlike behavior. Manure must be picked up in parking lot and in arena. **Concessions:** Home-made soups, baked potatoes, hot chocolate and bottled water (with other assorted goodies) on sale. **Directions to Birt Arena:** From I-84: Take Nampa exit 38 (Garrity Blvd/Idaho Center exit). Turn south from off-ramp. Stay in left lane for a left turn (east) at the second stop light-Flamingo Ave. Take a right turn on to Happy Valley Rd. and go approximately 5 miles. Turn right onto Lewis Lane. Go approximately 1.4 miles to Hestehaven Lane (after Southside Blvd, before the NY Canal). Turn right on Hestehaven and follow the dirt road into parking lot. Mid Jumper Division:

Class 4-A 2'3" Jumper	-250mpm	(AM, first class)
Class 5- 2'6" Jumper	-300mpm	(approx. 11 miles per hour)
Class 6- 2'9" Jumper	-300mpm	

High Jumper Division:

Class 7- 3' Jumper	-320mpm	(approx. 12 miles per hour)
Class 8- 3'3" Jumper	-320mpm	
Class 9- 3'6" jumper	-350mpm	(approx. 13 miles per hour)

Class format: Time is based on meters per minute. All classes will be judged as follows: *The placing is decided by adding the faults incurred over the course, lowest faults win over higher faults. Time is not a judging factor if faults are different. If faults are the same, they will be placed according to proximity to "optimum time" (over OR under) in full seconds. If there is a tie using the full-second method, then: 1. Pre-entry wins over post entry. If the tie is between 2 pre-entry riders OR 2 post-entry riders, then we will factor in a tenth of a second or a hundredth of a second to break a tie 2. The person within the full second who is closest to .00 wins - further judging rules are posted on-site in the "Optimum Times and Rules" sheet.*

I understand that my participation involves all inherent risks associated with the dangers and conditions which are an integral part of equine activities, including, but not limited to, the propensity of equines to behave in ways which may result in injury, harm or even death to humans or other animals around or near them; the unpredictability of equine reactions to sounds, sudden movements, smells, and unfamiliar objects; persons or other animals; hazards related to surface and subsurface conditions; collisions with other equines or objects; and, the potential of a participant to act in a negligent or unskilled manner which may contribute to injury to the participant or others, including falling or inability to maintain control over the animal.
