Management reserves the right to cancel, combine, split classes, change arenas, or limit the number of rides per rider to facilitate the schedule. Management reserves the right to refuse any entry.

Freestyle music check will be conducted **each day** BEFORE the official show start time.

If you would like your pony measured, please notify the Show Manager or Secretary by May 30, 2018. No exceptions. Any person wanting pony measurements must contact the Show Manager before the show to set a measurement time – we will tentatively measure ponies Friday evening, Saturday and Sunday during lunch times, but other times may be arranged. Owners will pay veterinarian directly for call charge.

DRESSAGE AT LES BOIS I & II 2018

ENTRY FEES:

- \$40 Opportunity Classes, Dressage Seat, and Materiale
- \$50 Training thru Fourth Levels and Para Dressage
- \$55 FEI Classes and Freestyles
- \$15 Additional fee for each Great American/USDF Qualifying Class entered
- \$20 Office Fee, **each day, each entry form**
- \$45 USEF Show Pass Fee
- \$35 USDF Non-member Fee

ADDITIONAL FEES:

- \$25 Post Entry Fee** if space allows **or** changes after closing date
- \$15 Class add/change**—per class
- \$25 Incomplete Entry and missing cards**—Paid at Check In (Competition Management reserves the right to review incomplete entries and associated fees on a case by case basis.)

ENTRIES: Make checks payable to **Les Bois Dressage, LLC** and send to **SECRETARY** listed above. Use [Entry Form B](#) available at www.idahodressageandeventing.org. **ODS members please put your ODS# under "local" box.** All entries must be **postmarked** by the closing date, any late entries will be accepted at the discretion of management and put on a waiting list. Classes filled on a first-come first-serve basis and the show fills fast. No assurances will be made until the schedule is printed. ***All copies of membership cards must be included. Go to egverification.org to find and print them all in one place!** Except for USEF/USDF Championship classes and for FEI Pony Riders, FEI Junior, FEI Young Rider and FEI Para-Equestrian Freestyles, in order to enter a freestyle class at any level, **a horse/rider combination must have received a minimum score of 60% in the highest test of the declared freestyle level or any test of a higher level** at a Federation Licensed or FEI recognized Dressage Competition or "open" Dressage class (i.e. open to all breeds) at a Federation Licensed Competition held prior to the competition where the horse/rider combination is entered to ride a freestyle class. A photocopy of the test verifying eligibility or copy of the USDF score verification, must be submitted with the entry for a freestyle class.

VACCINATIONS NOTICE: Exhibitors are reminded of USEF's new vaccination policy, effective 12/1/15; see GR845 for details. Download the form from: <https://www.usef.org/documents/membership/EquineVaccinationRecord.pdf> and bring the completed form, signed by your veterinarian, with you to the competition. If you select an alternative option under the rules, please bring required documentation. Competition Management reserves the right to review vaccination documentation. Non-compliant entries may be quarantined or denied permission to unload, and will not be allowed to compete nor to mingle with other horses. **No refunds will be given if right to compete is denied because the vaccination documentation is missing or incomplete.**

SCRATCHES/REFUNDS: Please be aware of opening and closing dates. Refunds will be all fees minus \$50 cancellation fee prior to closing date. No refunds after closing date or at discretion of management.

TIMES: The preferred method of notification for all entries is email, so please include a clearly readable email address with entry. Ride times will also be posted at the show in a conspicuous place by 12pm the day before and available on Fox Village website. It is the competitor's responsibility to confirm ride times on the day of the show.

STABLING VERY LIMITED: Please contact Nadine Schwartzman to arrange & pay separately from show entry. nadine.schwartzman@gmail.com PACKAGE PRICE of \$100 for the show weekend (Friday thru Sunday, horse stall. NO tack stalls available), If arriving before Friday additional nights at \$40, initial bedding provided. Feed and bedding (\$10/bag) available for purchase. Les Bois Dressage will do the final cleaning upon departure. No Coggins required for Idaho horses (out of State please include Coggins), but see Vaccinations Notice above.

ARENAS: All tests will be ridden in a 20x60 meter outdoor dressage arena with hoofgrid base and GGF footing. If Training Level is very full, we may change the arena to a 20x40 meter arena to accommodate more riders. Indoor warmup area 20m x 40m. Indoor Lunging area 20m x 20m. Outdoor warm-up arena adjacent to competition arena (limited # of horses at a time) approx. 20m x 60m with hoofgrid base and GGF footing.

AWARDS:

- Prize to first and ribbons to six places.
- **Show High Point:** Embroidered saddle pad for Junior, Amateur and Open- both shows; awarded to the highest score of the day (freestyles, materiale classes and 4-5-6 year old divisions NOT included).
- **Champion and Reserve Champion:** awarded in each division at each level. Combined score of two tests in that level to determine winner thru 2nd Level. 3rd Level and above, highest score. FEI Level will be combined.
- **Les Bois Weekend high point Awards:** Cash prizes for Weekend High Point- highest score. Young Horse-Champion-\$150, Reserve Champion-\$50. High Point FEI-Champion-\$150, Reserve Champion-\$50.
- **PNW High Performance Freestyle Gala:** Cash prizes for Champion- \$400, Reserve Champion- \$200.

SPECIAL CLASSES:

- PNW High Performance Freestyle Gala (all Saturday freestyles are presented in the gala Saturday eve).
- Opportunity Training Level Tests 1 & 2 (**Class 100/200**) are classes made available for riders who are experimenting with dressage showing (USEF GR821). These entries must pay all other show related fees (office, grounds, stabling, etc.), but the Opportunity classes do not require the USEF/USDF drug fee or memberships or nonmember fees for either horse or rider/owner/trainer or coach. Riders entering Opportunity classes may not cross enter into the rated/recognized classes.
- **Class 138/238** for Adult Amateur riders can be used as a qualifying for an Adult Amateur Equitation Regional Final. Please refer to USDF: www.usdf.org/docs/ShowFlash/web/Docsprizelist/2018_USDF_AA_Slick.pdf

AA High Score 2nd - 4th Level \$100 and prize
Junior/Young Rider High Score \$150 Champion, \$100 Reserve Champion (sponsored by IDEA)

In order to be eligible for this award a rider/horse combination has to compete in the Boise River Show **AND** the Dressage at Les Bois show. The highest score of each show count and the two scores will be averaged to create a ranking list.

Please send your awards application (attached to prize list) to the show secretary with you entry for the Boise River show and include the \$10 application fee payable to Les Bois Dressage, LLC with a separate check. The \$10 fee will be given back to the Pacific Northwest High Performance Dressage Foundation to support future grants.

For the FEI division all tests from PSG to GP are eligible, including the Developing PSG and GP, FEI Young Rider and U25 GP. Excluded are FEI Young Horse tests, Pony, Junior and all FEI Freestyles.

All levels are eligible for the Junior/Young Rider Award. (no opportunity/Introductory classes, freestyles, Materiale, Dressage Seat Equitation)

A minimum average of 63% is required to receive the prize money.

Awards recipients **must be present for mounted** awards presentations and photographs early Sunday afternoon.

OTHER:
