**FEES:**

Intro: \$20 per class  
Training-Second: \$25 per class  
Musical Freestyle: \$25 per class  
Western Dressage: \$25 per class  
Dressage Trail, Prix Caprilli, and Pas de Deux: \$15 per class  
\$20 Office Fee (each entry)  
\$15 Late/change fee per horse  
\$10 Trailer-in Fee per day/per horse (if not stabling on grounds)

**ENTRIES:** Mail complete entry to: Mike Taylor, Show Secretary, 1352 W Syphon Road, Pocatello, ID 83204. Make checks payable to: C&M Farm. Entry forms can be found online at: [www.idahodressageandeventing.org](http://www.idahodressageandeventing.org) and clicking on members and then forms (**USE ENTRY FORM A**) or by contacting secretary. Entries are also available online at [www.equestrianentries.com](http://www.equestrianentries.com). Classes filled on a first-come first-served basis according to postmark. Post entries will only be accepted if time slots are available with a late fee of \$15. Out of state competitors must provide a current negative Coggins and health certificate.

**REFUNDS:** Prior to closing date, all fees are refundable except the office fee. After the closing date, refunds are limited to those with medical/veterinary proof minus a \$50 handling fee. If wait listed entries cannot be accepted because of a full show, all fees will be refunded. NO refunds on competition days. Refunds will NOT be given for class cancellation due to severe weather, accident or other emergency.

**TIMES:** Will be notified by phone or via email if e-mail address provided. It is the competitor's responsibility to confirm ride times on the day of the show.

**AWARDS:** Ribbons will be awarded first through fourth in each class for JR/YR and AA/Open. Ties will be broken in accordance with USEF DR123. In case of equality of points, the competitor with the highest marks received under General Impressions shall be declared the winner. When the scores for General Impressions are equal, the horses must remain tied. No prize money will be offered. High point awards at Training, First, and Second level. Must ride both days to qualify. Average of highest score each day.

**STABLING:** Limited available on grounds. \$30 per night. 12X12 stalls with bedding or 12 X 40 run w/ shelter. Please provide own hay. Contact Taylor's at 208-637-2755. No tack stalls available. Day stalls based on availability—check with Mike.

**FOOTING:** Warm up: Indoor Arena: 20 x 40 meters, sand footing. Outdoor Arena: 20 x 60 meters, sand. Round pen available for lunging. Only horses with entries will be permitted in arenas. Numbers are required at all times when the horse is outside their stall.

**CONCESSIONS:** TBA. **BBQ on Saturday night for all volunteers and competitors.**

**FARRIER AND VETERANARIAN:** On call. Names and phone numbers will be posted in the stable area and show office. Sharps containers in the show office and in the barn.

**SMOKING AND PETS:** Not allowed on show grounds.

**ACCOMMODATIONS:** Camping in pasture & shower available on grounds. Ramada Inn, 208-237-0020. Motel 6, 208-237-7880. Others available. Call Taylor's.

**DIRECTIONS:** From I-15, merge onto I-86. From I-86, take Exit 58 (West Pocatello). Turn North (right) and proceed until road T's. Turn left onto Tank Farm Road. Continue 2 miles to stop sign. Turn left onto Syphon Road. Proceed approximately 1 mile. Entrance is on left hand side of road. From Boise/Twin Falls on I-86 take Exit 52 (Arbon Valley). Turn North (left) and proceed until road T's. Turn right onto Syphon Road. Continue approximately 3 miles. At crossroad Government Road, entrance past third house on the right. Watch for signs.
