ENTRIES: Mail complete entry to: Mike Taylor, Show Secretary, 1352 W Syphon Road, Pocatello, ID 83204. Make checks payable to: **Bozeman Dressage Society**. Classes filled on a first-come first-served basis according to postmark or email from electronic entry. Entries not accepted without full payment, all signatures, and copies of membership cards or www.eqverification.org printout. You may use www.eqverification.

VACCINATION NOTICE: All horses must be vaccinated for Strangles within the past six months to seven days of the show date or have titer paperwork and signed note from veterinarian. Exhibitors are reminded of USEF's new vaccination policy, effective 12/1/15; see GR845 for details. Download the form from: https://files.usef.org/assets/R8HwrnhaKZ8/equinevaccinationrecord.pdf and bring the completed form, signed by your veterinarian, with you to the competition. If you select an alternative option under the rules, please bring required documentation. Competition Management reserves the right to review vaccination documentation. Non-compliant entries may be quarantined or denied permission to unload, and will not be allowed to compete nor to mingle with other horses. **No refunds will be given if right to compete is denied because the vaccination documentation is missing or incomplete**.

SPECIAL CLASSES:

- Class 135 Leadline is a group rail class and is open to children ages 0-10. Class 235 is a walk/trot test. Test is available at the show office or can be emailed if needed. These are not USDF/USEF class. Children must have a helmet and heeled boots to participate. There is no fee for this class, but grounds fees apply and the parent/guardian must sign all release forms for the rider.
- Opportunity Training Level Tests 1 & 2, and Opportunity First Level Tests 1 & 2 are classes made available for riders who are experimenting with dressage showing (USEF GR821). These entries must pay all other show related fees (office, grounds, and stabling, etc. **BUT** not USEF drug free), but the Opportunity classes do not require USEF/USDF memberships or nonmember fees for either horse or rider/owner/trainer or coach. Riders entering Opportunity classes may not cross enter into the rated/recognized classes, but they may enter into Introductory classes which are not rated/recognized.
- Classes 123/223 and 125/225 are offered as an additional opportunity to earn a qualifying ride and are being scheduled at the end of the day. Please note that you are allowed one Qualifying score per show.

REFUNDS: Prior to closing date, all fees refunded <u>except</u> office fee. After the closing date, no refunds for any reason including Acts of God will be given. Drug, qualifying fees and facility fees will be refunded. No refunds on competition days. If wait listed entries cannot be accepted because of a full show, all fees will be refunded. Refunds will NOT be given for class cancellation due to severe weather, accident, or other emergency.

TIMES: The preferred method of notification for all entries is email, so please include a clearly readable email address with entry. It is the competitor's responsibility to confirm ride times on the day of the show.

AWARDS: Ribbons will be awarded first through sixth in each division. Awards to be given to High Point in all divisions for the each day of the show, but additional awards will be determined depending on amount of entries. Ties will be broken in accordance with USEF DR123. In case of equality of points, the competitor with the highest marks received under General Impressions shall be declared the winner. When the scores for General Impressions are equal, the horses must remain tied.

STABLING: All stabling will be provided on site. Haul in are allowed. Stalls will be assigned and a list posed in the event barn. Please indicate stabling group on your entry. You need to bring your own water buckets, bucket hangers, bridle & saddle racks, and manure removal equipment. Stall per day fee includes arrival the night before and one bag of shavings for your entire stay. If available, tack stalls will be assigned in the order entries are received. Additional bag shavings and hay bales are available on site for a fee. You may bring your own hay.

Stabling Packages:

- A: Show Package, Stabling or Tack for one night (May 11 or 12): \$45
- B: Show Package, Stabling or Tack (Arrive May 11, Leave May 13): \$90
- C: Additional Night/Day, Stabling or Tack (May 10 or/and May 14): \$30
- D: Additional Night/Day, Stabling and Schooling (May 10 or/and May 14): \$55*
- *This fee includes schooling/facility use. There is no limit to how many extra days you may add to either end of the show.

Please note: You must clean all stalls before leaving. A \$25 clean stall deposit must be left with the office at time of entry or registration. Unclean stall checks will be cashed. Tack stalls must be left clean.

FOOTING: The warm up arena has well maintained and watered sand-based footing and will be on the east side of the large arena. The dressage arena is 20 x 60 and is well maintained and watered sand-based footing. Lunging area is available. Only horses with entries will be permitted in arenas. Numbers are required at all times when the horse is outside their stall.

CONCESSIONS: On grounds during show hours.

FARRIER AND VETERANARIAN: On call. Farrier: Tom Peterson 406-599-1038. Veterinary: All West Veterinary Hospital 406-586-4919. Names and phone numbers will be posted in the stable area and show office. Sharps containers in the show office and in the event barn.

SMOKING AND PETS: No smoking on show grounds! Dog must be leashed at all times and owner is responsible for any damage or injury caused by the dog on the show grounds. Please pick up after your dog.

ACCOMMODATIONS: The official hotel is The Western Heritage Inn in Bozeman. Exhibitors receive a 20% discount on all rooms. Contact them today at: http://www.westernheritageinn.com or (406) 586-8534.

In addition, camping is available at Tri-H. Pay with entry. There are limited RV hookups with electricity. There is plenty of dry-camping available (no tents).

DIRECTIONS: From Huffine Lane in Bozeman, turn South onto Cottonwood Road for 4 miles, turn right onto Johnson Road for 0.6 miles, and turn left onto Van Dyke Road for 0.4 miles. From the South, turn right onto Gooch Hill Road for 3 miles, turn right onto Johnson Road for 1.5 miles, and turn right onto Van Dyke Road for 0.4 miles.

The private easement speed limit is 15 mph, please drive slow and respect the neighbors...and mind the pot holes. The first barn you see on your right is the event barn. Please unload on the North end of the event barn and park in an orderly fashion on the North side of the parking area adjacent to the event barn. Please park in the designated area for your vehicle.

Please respect our neighbors and <u>do not ride horses or drive south on Vandyke road past the Tri-H entrance</u>. Do not drive to Tri-H from the south on Vandyke road. Thank you.
