CLINICIAN BIOGRAPHY:

Barbi Breen-Gurley has been an active dressage trainer and instructor since 1970 after attaining her BHSAI from Moat House, England. She has won numerous local, state and national championships each year and has been on the USEF Long List and Developing Rider List several times on her different horses through the years. She is a USDF Gold Medalist and has trained eight of her horses to the Grand Prix Level. She is a Senior Dressage Judge and a Quadrille Judge. She owns Sea Horse Ranch in Los Osos, CA, a boarding and training facility.

Barbi competed with “Vindicator” at the Grand Prix level and has placed impressively. Recently, in 2014, Vindicator placed 5th in the Grand Prix Freestyle event at the National Dressage Finals in Kentucky. In 2010, Barbi and “Octango” won state and western regional Grand Prix Champion. Her youngster “Dante Heir” and her new KWPN mare “Bienenta” are starting to compete at 3rd level.

Barbi has also co-authored a book with Janet Emmons, Enlightened Riding, and produced an audio CD series on “Guided Imagery”. This visualization method helps the rider work on their “inner-arena” and empowers the rider to overcome fear, set realistic goals and improve their competitive edge.
