WHAT DO I PAY?

You must pay all other show related fees (office, grounds, stabling, etc.), but the Opportunity classes at USEF/USEF shows do not require the USEF/USDF drug fee or memberships or nonmember fees for either horse or rider/owner/trainer or coach.

CAN I CROSS-ENTER INTO A USEF/USDF RECOGNIZED CLASSES?

Riders entering Opportunity classes in USEF/USDF shows may or may not cross-enter into the rated/recognized classes. If you ARE cross-entering, then you do need to pay all appropriate fees accordingly. Please read the rules of the particular show you are entering to know their policy on cross-entering. USEF/USEF class scores do not count towards league year-end awards.

WHAT HEALTH PAPERS DO I NEED TO SHOW IN OPPORTUNITY CLASSES AT A USEF/USDF SHOW?

Coggins test and health certificate not required for entries (They ARE required to travel between states with your horse. See individual show requirements.) New starting 2016, a "Vaccination Report" IS REQUIRED in order to show at a USEF/USDF shows.
