**Entries/Fees:** \$15 Grounds fee per horse to off-set arena rental and insurance costs. \$10 per Class before closing date, after closing date \$13 per class. You may enter more than once in the same class for schooling, but only one may be judged- you must declare which will be judged with ring steward before starting the round. Classes may be split into Junior (under 18) and senior (18 and over) if 6 entries or more in a class. Please make Checks payable to the "Nancy Roché". Refunds in full (or applied to next show in series) before closing date, after closing entries may be applied to another show in the series, minus \$15 grounds fee. Day of show scratches or no-shows, no refund or credit given. **Times:** Approximate ride times will be sent via email 3-4 days prior to the event. Post entries will be accepted if space allows, and put at the end of each class order. **Awards:** Award for 1<sup>st</sup> place if two or more in class. Ribbons thru 4<sup>th</sup> place. Year-end Winter Jumper Series Champion and Reserve Champion awarded to the same horse/rider combination for the series- Low jumper, Mid Jumper and High Jumper divisions. Points are as follows: 1<sup>st</sup> -50, 2<sup>nd</sup> -25, 3<sup>rd</sup> -15, 4<sup>th</sup> -10. You do not need to enter every class of division! Must compete in 3 of the series shows in one division to be eligible for a year-end award in that division. **Ties:** In case of tie, pre-entered horse/rider will win over post-entered. If still tied, tie remains. **Warmups:** There will be approximately one-hour open warm up time in the indoor arena prior to mid/high and low show (10 horses max, may limit time to 20-30 mins to allow for next group), plus you may warm up indoors while we set fences to a different height. You may lunge or ride outside as weather allows- no lunging in the indoor arena. Standing horses may be in the indoor holding area or held/tied outside. **Attire:** Clinic attire. Riding helmet and riding boots or paddock boots with half chaps a must. **Other info:** **Request a song and/or bring your own ipod or CD and we will play it for you!** No dogs allowed on the grounds according with Birt Arena policies. Management reserves the right to excuse any competitor, trainer or spectator for unsportsmanlike behavior. Manure must be picked up in parking lot and in arena. **Concessions:** Home-made soups, baked potatoes, hot chocolate and bottled water (with other assorted goodies) on sale. **Directions to Birt Arena:** From I-84: Take Nampa exit 38 (Garrity Blvd/Idaho Center exit). Turn south from off-ramp. Stay in left lane for a left turn (east) at the second stop light-Flamingo Ave. Take a right turn on to Happy Valley Rd. and go approximately 5 miles. Turn right onto Lewis Lane. Go approximately 1.4 miles to Hestehaven Lane (after Southside Blvd, before the NY Canal). Turn right on Hestehaven and follow the dirt road into parking lot. Ignore the "Private / No Trespassing" sign when entering.

Class 3- 2' Jumper -250 mpm (approx 9 miles per hour)

**ADDED!** Class 4-P 2'3 jumper -250mpm *(PM, after class 3)- counts towards mid jumper division year end awards*

### Mid Jumper Division:

Class 4-A 2'3" Jumper -250 mpm *(AM, first class- 11am)*  
Class 5- 2'6" Jumper -300 mpm (approx 11 miles per hour)  
Class 6- 2'9" Jumper -300 mpm

### High Jumper Division:

Class 7- 3' Jumper -320 mpm (approx 12 miles per hour)  
Class 8- 3'3" Jumper -320 mpm  
Class 9- 3'6" jumper -350 mpm (approx 13 miles per hour)

**Class format:** Time is based on Meters per minute. All classes will be judged as a **USEF Table IV, Sec 1 Optimum time first round:** "The first round is decided by adding the faults incurred over the course and any penalties for exceeding the time allowed In the case of equality of faults, ties will be broken on the following basis: an "Optimum time", defined as 4 seconds less than the time allowed for the course) will be posted on the course plan; the horse with the time on course closest to this optimum time (over or under) will prevail in the tie, next closest, etc"

**RELEASE OF LIABILITY**  
**For the North Wind Winter Jumping Series**

Please read carefully:

I understand that horse activities, including shows, are high-risk sports and involve inherently dangerous risks of serious injury or death. I am participating in this horse show at my own risk. In consideration of the organization of this show, I hereby assume this risk, and further do hereby on behalf of myself, my executors, administrators, heirs, next of kin, successors and assigns: (1) release and hold harmless the organizer, organizing committee, the IDEA, volunteers, judges, officials, and Birt Arena (collectively referred to as "Releasees") from any and all liability for actor or omissions resulting in accidents, damage, death, injury, or illness to myself and to my property, including the horse or horses which I will compete at this horse show; and (2) indemnify the Releasees from any and all liabilities or claims made by other individuals or entities as a result of my actions, or the actions of my horse, during this event.

**Warning:** Under Idaho law, an equine activity sponsor is not liable for injury to or death of a participant or equine engaged in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities. No participant or participant's representative may maintain an action against or recover from an equine activity sponsor or an equine professional for injury to or the death of a participant or equine engaged in an equine activity or resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities. See Equine Immunity Act, I.C. § 6-1801, *et seq.*

This agreement shall be governed by the laws of the State of Idaho. This Release of Liability shall be construed broadly to provide a release and waiver of liability to the maximum extent permissible under law.
