Entries/Fees: \$15 Grounds fee per horse to off-set arena rental and insurance costs. \$10 per Class before closing date, after closing date \$15 per class. You may enter more than once in the same class for schooling, but only one will be your competition round. Classes may be split into Junior (under 18) for the low division. Refunds in full (or applied to next show in series) before closing date, after closing entries may be applied to another show in the series, minus \$15 grounds fee. Day of show scratches or no-shows, no refund & no credit given. **Awards:** Award for 1st place if two or more in class. Ribbons thru 4th place. Year-end Winter Jumper Series Champion and Reserve Champion awarded to the same horse/rider combination for the series- Low jumper, Mid Jumper and High Jumper divisions. Points are as follows: 1st-50, 2nd-25, 3rd-15, 4th-10. You do not need to enter every class of division! Must compete in 3 of the series shows in one division to be eligible for a year-end award in that division. **Ties:** In case of tie, pre-entered horse/rider will win over post-entered. If still tied, tie remains. **Warmups:** There will be a brief warm up allowed in the indoor arena prior to each divisions (4 horses max, managed by show staff). **Attire:** Riding helmet and boots with a low heel must be worn. **Other info:** NO DOGS ALLOWED on the grounds in accordance with Birt Arena policies. *Management reserves the right to excuse any competitor, trainer or spectator for unsportsmanlike behavior.*
Manure must be picked up in parking lot. CLEAN UP after yourself. Concessions: will be available for purchase and support a local horse club.

Class List

Mid Jumper Division:

- Class 1-A 2'3" Jumper -250 mpm (AM, first class- 10am)
- Class 2- 2'6" Jumper -300 mpm (approx 11 miles per hour)
- Class 3- 2'9" Jumper -300 mpm

High Jumper Division:

- Class 4- 3' Jumper -320 mpm (approx 12 miles per hour)
- Class 5- 3'3" Jumper -320 mpm
- Class 6- 3'6" jumper -350 mpm (approx 13 miles per hour)

Low Jumper Division: (Classes split into Jr. and Sr.)

- Class 7- Ground Poles -200 mpm (approx 7 miles per hour)
- Class 8- XRails -200 mpm
- Class 9- 2' Jumper -250 mpm (approx 9 miles per hour)
- Class 1-P 2'3 jumper -250mpm (PM, after class 3)- counts towards mid jumper division year end awards

Class format: Time is based on Meters per minute. All classes will be judged as a **USEF Table IV, Sec 1 Optimum time first round:** "The first round is decided by adding the faults incurred over the course and any penalties for exceeding the time allowed in the case of equality of faults, ties will be broken on the following basis: an "Optimum time", defined as 4 seconds less than the time allowed for the course) will be posted on the course plan; the horse with the time on course closest to this optimum time (over or under) will prevail in the tie, next closest, etc

Directions to Birt Arena: From I-84: Take Nampa exit 38 (Garrity Blvd/Idaho Center exit). Turn south from off-ramp. Stay in left lane for a left turn (east) at the second stop light-Flamingo Ave. Take a right turn on to Happy Valley Rd. and go approximately 5 miles. Turn right onto Lewis Lane. Go approximately 1.4 miles to Hestehaven Lane (after Southside Blvd, before the NY Canal). Turn right on Hestehaven and follow the dirt road into parking lot. Ignore the "Private / No Trespassing" sign when entering.

I understand that the sport of eventing is a high risk sport, and that my participation in this educational activity may also involve participation in an "equine activity" as defined by applicable laws and is solely at my own risk. I understand that my participation involves all inherent risks associated with the dangers and conditions which are an integral part of equine activities, including, but not limited to, the propensity of equines to behave in ways which may result in injury, harm or even death to humans or other animals around or near them; the unpredictability of equine reaction to sounds, sudden movements, smells, and unfamiliar objects; persons or other animals; hazards related to surface and subsurface conditions; collisions with other equines or objects; and, the potential of a participant to act in a negligent or unskilled manner which may contribute to injury to the participant or others, including failing or inability to maintain control over the animal. By participating in this activity I agree to assume responsibility for those risks, and I release and agree to hold harmless the activity organizer, organizing committee, officials, the USEA, USEF, their officers, agents, employees and the volunteers assisting in the conduct of this USEA educational activity and the owners of any property on which it is to be held, from all liability for negligence resulting in accidents, damage, injury or illness to myself and to my property, including the horse(s) which I may ride.
