A dressage test followed by a jumping round consisting of a combination of stadium and cross country obstacles. All dressage tests will be in 20m x 40m sand arena.

The dressage will be scored on penalty points, the faults for jumping will be scored as show jumping, and the time will be scored as cross country with a designated speed. There will be 12-22 obstacles per division as per USEF/USEA specifications.

Attire: Casual/clinic. Braiding/jackets not required. Helmets, boots with heel, XC vests a must. Armbands required.

Cross Country Schooling Prior to Event:

Open XC School: \$35 /horse rider/ Lessons available by appointment. Open from 8am-5pm Saturday prior to event.

Fees/Awards: Ground Fee: \$10/horse competing or non-competing. \$50 for full derby. Awards for first full derby only, 1-6. Second Derby~same combination \$40 for full derby no ribbons. Added jump rounds with derby entry \$15, no ribbons / Jump rounds only with no derby entry, \$25, no ribbons / Dressage only \$20/class Ribbons 1-6. Late/change fee \$10 after closing date. Refunds prior to CD less \$25 office fee. After CD, less \$25 office fee and vet/doc note within two weeks. No shows forfeit all.

X-Country

Our Pegasus, 2'0" division includes logs, pipes, elephant toes, stacked poles, canoe, coop, half barrels, tires, and some stadium jumps.

IBN, BN, N, T, P include logs, ramps, coops, chevron, cordwood, ditches, up banks, down banks, wood wagon, twist, palisade, water option, wood carving, skinnies, and roll tops.

Stabling \$30/night. Pipe panels, no coverings. No panels in pasture. Primitive camping in pasture. Initial bedding provided. \$10/bale thereafter.

Dressage tests will be the *same all year* for the following: Ground Poles, Cross Rails, and Pegasus.

Novice through Preliminary: *May & June Dressage Test "A". **July & October Dressage Test "B".

Prizes: Ribbons 1-6, small prize for 1st with three entries in class for first full derby and Dressage only classes.

Championship and Reserve: Must compete in 3 out of 4 Event Derbies. Must be same horse/rider combination. Must be minimum three horses entered in entire division for championship. Ties broken by dressage collectives. If still tied, closest to optimum time for XC. Jr/Sr divisions as entries warrant.
