Management reserves the right to cancel, combine, split classes, change arenas, or limit the number of rides per rider to facilitate the schedule. Management reserves the right to refuse any entry.

ENTRIES: Mail complete entry to: Mike Taylor, Show Secretary, 1352 W Syphon Road, Pocatello, ID 83204. Make checks payable to: EIC of IDEA. Entries are available online at www.horseshowoffice.com or use entry form below. Classes filled on a first-come first-served basis according to date/time stamp from paid entry or mailing postmark. Post entries will only be accepted if time slots are available with a late fee of \$15. Out of state competitors must provide a current negative Coggins and health certificate.

FEES:

All classes are \$20 each test
\$10 Office Fee (each entry)
\$15 Late/change fee per horse
\$10 Trailer-in Fee per day/per horse (if not stabling on grounds)
Stabling: \$35 per night
Day Stall: \$30

COVID-19 STATEMENT: Managing your risk of exposure to the Coronavirus is essential to maintaining good health. At this time, it is appropriate to be cognizant of proper hygiene and incorporating common sense actions into your everyday activities in order to prevent the spread of this virus. Practices such as regularly washing your hands with soap and water or an alcohol based hand sanitizer; practicing good sneeze and cough hygiene; avoiding touching your mouth, nose and eyes with unwashed hands; avoiding close contact with people who are sick; and disinfecting and cleaning often touched objects and surfaces can help reduce your risk of exposure. We will have several sanitation stations on the grounds.

Any person who has a temperature of 100.4 (F) or higher or has symptoms of COVID-19 cannot enter the competition grounds. Additionally, except for healthcare personnel who have treated patients using appropriate medical-grade PPE during the course of performing professional duties, anyone who has been in contact with a person who has tested positive for COVID-19 in the past 10 days cannot enter the competition grounds.

Following guidelines from rated shows, if social distancing and/or mandatory requirements are not followed, that person will be removed from the facility and no refund will be issued.

RETURNED CHECKS: Checks returned by a bank for any reason are regarded as a most serious offense and will be handled according to the following procedures: \$50 will be assessed for each returned check or any check with a stop payment; \$50 will be assessed for any declined or stop payment on declined credit card payments; accounts will be given ten (10) days to be paid in full or they will be turned into USEF for further disciplinary action; accounts left unpaid—rider, owner or horse will not be allowed to compete at any event at C&M Farm, licensed by show management at other facilities, and/or will not be allowed on show grounds until past account(s) are paid in full.

CHECK-IN (& No-shows): Exhibitor number will not be released until show fees are paid. All exhibitors or representatives must check in with the Show Office and pick up their exhibitor number at least 60 minutes PRIOR to their FIRST class for the show. Exhibitors that have not checked in with the Show Office and received their show number (even those with bridle number holders) will be considered a NO-SHOW and be scratched from the rest of the show and time slots may be filled. All "No Shows" that have not contacted the show office will be considered a scratch for the rest of the show and no refund will be issued.

MANAGEMENT RIGHTS: Show management reserves the right to make any changes deemed necessary for the safe and efficient conduct of this competition. Show management reserves the right to interpret all questions and conditions in regard to or arising out of any incident in the show without claims for damages or recourse of any kind. All questions not covered in these rules and regulations shall be decided by Show Management and their decision shall be final. Show management reserves the right to vary or add officials and refuse any entry for a cause; to disqualify any exhibitor and/or his or her horse for cause; to cause an exhibitor to forfeit his or her ribbons and winnings for cause; to return any entry and/or stall fee before or during the show for cause; all without being liable for damage or compensation. Management reserves the right to cancel any classes due to hazardous weather, Acts of God, accident, or emergency. Every effort will be made to reschedule. No refunds for cancellations due to hazardous weather, Acts of God, accidents, or emergencies.

EXHIBITOR/COMPETITOR RESPONSIBILITY: It is the exhibitor's responsibility to verify the accuracy of test scores. Any scoring errors must be reported to the Show Secretary and/or assistant within one hour of the last ridden test for that class. Failure to report any errors within allowed time will mean the error will not be corrected and there will be no change in class placing. It is the rider/owner/member responsibility to make sure of their membership status is correct. Exhibitors are responsible for presenting themselves to the ring at their designated time and accept the full responsibility for doing so regardless of announcements or ring stewards. No protest will be upheld, nor ride time changed due to failure of the exhibitor to meeting their responsibilities.

REFUNDS: Prior to closing date, all fees are refundable except the office fee. After the closing date, refunds are limited to those with medical/veterinary proof minus a \$25 handling fee. If wait listed entries cannot be accepted because of a full show, all fees will be refunded. NO refunds on competition days. Refunds will NOT be given for class cancellation due to severe weather, accident or other emergency.

TIMES: Will be notified by phone or via email if e-mail address provided. It is the competitor's responsibility to confirm ride times on the day of the show.

AWARDS: Ribbons will be awarded first through third in each class. Ties will be broken in accordance with USEF DR123. In case of equality of points, the competitor with the highest marks received under General Impressions shall be declared the winner. When the scores for General Impressions are equal, the horses must remain tied. No prize money will be offered. High point awards for each division each day.

STABLING: Limited available on grounds. \$35 per night. 12X12 stalls or 12 X 40 run w/ shelter—first bag of shavings included. Additional available for \$12 or you can bring own. Please provide own hay. Contact Taylor's at 208-637-2755. No tack stalls available. Day stalls based on availability at \$30 during the show—check with Mike.

FOOTING: Warm up: Indoor Arena: 20 x 40 meters, sand footing with Premier Athletix. Outdoor Arena: 20 x 60 meters, sand with Premier Crumb rubber. Round pen available for lunging. Only horses with entries will be permitted in arenas. Numbers are required at all times when the horse is outside their stall.\

HELMETS: From the time horses are officially admitted to the competition grounds by competition management, anyone mounted on a horse at any time on the competition grounds, including non-competing riders, riders on non-competing horses, mounted participants in exhibition classes and those competing in all classes and tests, including Para-Equestrian tests, must wear protective headgear as define by DR120.6 and otherwise in compliance with GR801. Any rider violating this rule at any time must immediately be prohibited from further riding until such headgear is properly in place.

CONSECUTIVE LEVELS: Horses may enter no more than two consecutive levels, Freestyle levels included, at any one competition.

CONCESSIONS: Bottled water and some pre-packaged food. Plan accordingly.

FARRIER AND VETERANARIAN: On call. Names and phone numbers will be posted in the stable area and show office. Sharps containers in the show office and in the barn.

SMOKING AND PETS: Not allowed on show grounds.

ACCOMMODATIONS: Camping in pasture & shower available on grounds. Official hotel is Marriot Towneplace Suites at 208-478-7000. Use Horseman's Discount! Others available. Call Taylor's.

DIRECTIONS: From I-15, merge onto I-86. From I-86, take Exit 58 (West Pocatello). Turn North (right) and proceed until road T's. Turn left onto Tank Farm Road. Continue 2 miles to stop sign. Turn left onto Syphon Road. Proceed approximately 1 mile. Entrance is on left hand side of road. From Boise/Twin Falls on I-86 take Exit 52 (Arbon Valley). Turn North (left) and proceed until road T's. Turn right onto Syphon Road. Continue approximately 3 miles. At crossroad Government Road, entrance past third house on the right. Watch for signs.
