Q- if riding GAIG/USDF qualifying, please specify which division and pay the additional \$15 qualifying fee. Please specify Open (O), Adult Amateur (AA), Jr. Young Rider (Jr./YR), on entry form. If not specified, you will be placed in the Open (O) division. Management reserves the right to cancel, combine, split classes, change arenas, or limit the number of rides per rider to facilitate the schedule. Management reserves the right to refuse any entry.

ENTRIES: At this time, we are moving to an online entry to lessen the contact between individuals. Classes filled on a first-come first-served basis according to postmark. Entries not accepted without full payment, all signatures, and proof of membership. Enter using www.equentries.com Juniors must provide Medical Release Form. Adult Amateurs must show USEF Amateur card.

Freestyle entries must include a copy of the qualifying test (63% score at highest test of level for Training-Fourth, 60% for FEI). Post entries will only be accepted if time slots are available with late fee of \$15. Out of state competitors must provide a current negative Coggins and health certificate.

COVID-19 Statement: Managing your risk of exposure to the Coronavirus is essential to maintaining good health. At this time, it is appropriate to be cognizant of proper hygiene and incorporating common sense actions into your everyday activities in order to prevent the spread of this virus. Practices such as regularly washing your hands with soap and water or an alcohol based hand sanitizer; practicing good sneeze and cough hygiene; avoiding touching your mouth, nose and eyes with unwashed hands; avoiding close contact with people who are sick; and disinfecting and cleaning often touched objects and surfaces can help reduce your risk of exposure. We will have several sanitation stations on the grounds.

Any person who has a temperature of 99.5 (F) or higher or has symptoms of COVID-19 cannot enter the competition grounds. Additionally, except for healthcare personnel who have treated patients using appropriate medical-grade PPE during the course of performing professional duties, anyone who has been in contact with a person who has tested positive for COVID-19 in the past 14 days cannot enter the competition grounds.

USEF and USDF require that all staff, grooms, trainers, and participants are required to wear a face mask or face covering when in a public setting when there is a possibility of being within six feet of another individual. Face masks and face coverings are not required when mounted on a horse. If social distancing and/or mandatory requirements are not followed, that person will be removed from the facility. The Technical Delegate must report instances of non-compliance to the Federation.

Competitors are limited to ***one*** additional person on the grounds—groom/trainer/etc. This is to limit contact between persons. We will not allow spectators.

VACCINATION NOTICE: Exhibitors are reminded of USEF's new vaccination policy, effective 12/1/15; see GR845 for details. Download the form from: <https://files.usef.org/assets/R8HwrnhaKZ8/equinevaccinationrecord.pdf> and bring the completed form, signed by your veterinarian, with you to the competition. If you select an alternative option under the rules, please bring required documentation. Competition Management reserves the right to review vaccination documentation. Non-compliant entries may be quarantined or denied permission to unload, and will not be allowed to compete nor to mingle with other horses. ***No refunds will be given if right to compete is denied because the vaccination documentation is missing or incomplete.***

SPECIAL CLASSES: Opportunity Training Level Tests 1 & 2, and Opportunity First Level Tests 1 & 2 are classes made available for riders who are experimenting with dressage showing (USEF GR821). These entries must pay all other show related fees (office, grounds, stabling, etc.), but the Opportunity classes do not require the USEF/USDF drug fee or memberships or nonmember fees for either horse or rider/owner/trainer or coach. Riders entering Opportunity classes may not cross enter into the rated/recognized classes but they may enter into Intro A/B/C classes which are not rated/recognized. Classes 124/224 & 127/227 are offered as an additional opportunity to earn a qualifying ride and scheduled at the end of the day. Please note you are allowed one Qualifying score per show.

REFUNDS: Prior to closing date, all fees refunded except office fee. After the closing date, no refunds for any reason including Acts of God will be given. Drug, qualifying fees and facility fees will be refunded. No refunds on competition days. If wait listed entries cannot be accepted because of a full show, all fees will be refunded. Refunds will NOT be given for class cancellation due to severe weather, accident, or other emergency.

TIMES: The preferred method of notification for all entries is email, so please include a clearly readable email address with entry. It is the competitor's responsibility to confirm ride times on the day of the show. The time schedule will be posted in a conspicuous place by noon the day before the competition. Ride times may not be changed after noon the day before the start of the entire competition, except in compliance with GR830.5.

AWARDS: Ribbons will be awarded first through third in each division. High point awards for each division each day. Ties will be broken in accordance with USEF DR123. In case of equality of points, the competitor with the highest marks received under General Impressions shall be declared the winner. When the scores for General Impressions are equal, the horses must remain tied. No prize money will be offered.

STABLING: Limited available on grounds. \$70 per weekend—Permanent and Hi-Hog 12X12 box stalls with 4' doors or 12X40 runs with a shelter and 12' gate. Please designate preference on entry. One bag of bedding provided. Please provide own hay. Additional hay/bedding available for purchase. Contact Taylor's at 208-637-2755 or idahodressage@gmail.com. For day stalls, check with management. No tack stalls available. Please observe social distance when in the stabling area to keep everyone safe.

FOOTING: Warm up: Indoor Arena: 20 x 40 meters, sand footing with Premier Athletex. Outdoor Arena: 20 x 60 meters, sand footing with Premier ProStride. Round pen available for lunging. Only horses with entries will be permitted in arenas. Numbers are required at all times when the horse is outside their stall.

CONCESSIONS: Under the Covid-19 guidelines, we will have bottled water and some limited pre-packaged snack food. Please plan accordingly for food needs.

MEDICAL: Medical personnel on grounds during competition.

FARRIER AND VETERANARIAN: On call. Names and phone numbers will be posted in the stable area and show office. Sharps containers in the show office and in the barn.

SMOKING AND PETS: Will not be allowed on show grounds.

ACCOMMODATIONS: Camping in pasture & shower available on grounds. Official hotel of the show is the Townplace suites by Marriot 208-478-7000. Mention C&M Farm show or ask for Jeff (Manager) or Crystal (Head of Sales)—receive Friends rate of \$89. Others available. Call Taylor's.

DIRECTIONS: **From I-15**, merge onto I-86. From I-86, take Exit 58 (West Pocatello). Turn North and proceed until road T's. Turn left onto Tank Farm Road. Continue 2 miles to stop sign. Turn left onto Syphon Road. Proceed approximately 1 mile. Entrance is on left hand side of road. **From Boise/Twin Falls** on I-86 take Exit 52 (Arbon Valley). Turn North and proceed until road T's. Turn right onto Syphon Road. Continue approximately 3 miles. At crossroad Government Road, entrance past third house on the right. Watch for signs.
