

EIC and IDEA Grant Program

The Eastern Idaho Chapter (EIC) of the Idaho Dressage and Eventing Association (IDEA) is excited to announce a new Grant Program for IDEA members!

In partnership with IDEA, EIC is offering two educational grants for 2022!

- \$250 for members who have selected Eastern Idaho as their chapter during membership renewal
- \$250 for IDEA members state-wide (any chapter affiliation or state-wide only)

Each grant is open to all rider divisions: Junior/YR, Adult Amateur and Open

Grants are to be used for educational purposes. Examples of educational purposes include, but are not limited to:

- Lessons with your regular trainer at your home/boarding barn
- Lessons with a trainer at a different barn
- Lessons in a Clinic
- Show Management Education/Certification
- Judges Programs

Examples of purposes the grant proceeds cannot be utilized for include but are not limited to:

- Tack, feed or any other supply purchases
- Regular boarding costs
- Show related expenses
- Membership renewals

What is required to apply for a grant?

The applicant must be a member of IDEA at the time the application is submitted

- If applying for the Eastern Idaho Chapter region grant, you must select Eastern Idaho as your chapter during the membership renewal process
- If applying for the state-wide grant, you can be a member of any chapter or a state member only

You may only apply for one of the grants; either EIC region or State-Wide

The applicant must complete the grant application process which includes the following steps:

- Fill out grant application form
- Submit either a short essay or a video message stating why you should be considered for the grant
- Include a brief summary of expenses
- Include a letter of recommendation

Should the date range or educational event submitted on your original application change, please inform the grant committee immediately.

Involvement or volunteerism in the Idaho Dressage and/or Eventing Community will be considered in the selection!
